Assignment/allocation of space

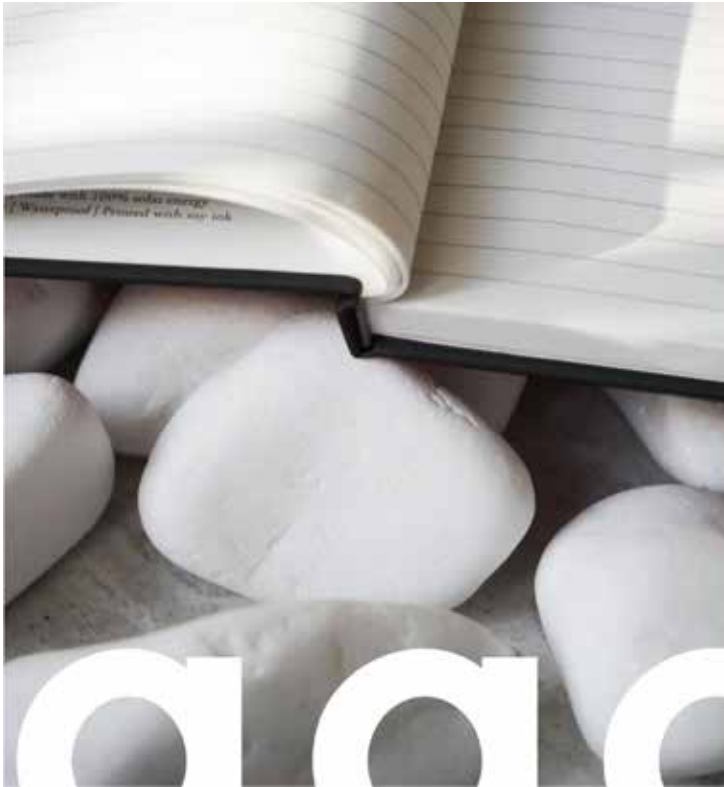

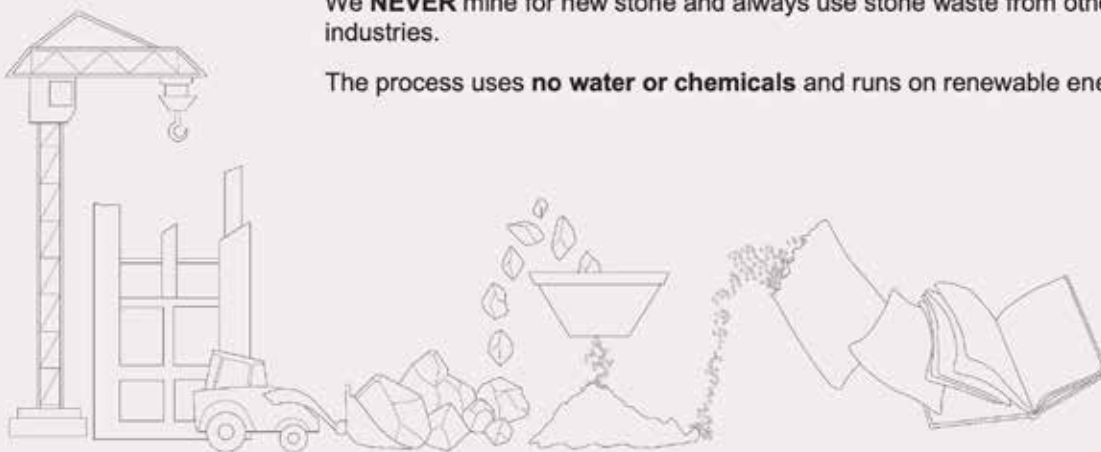

Payment Schedule

The amount of the invoice is due within 30 days of receipt. If full payment is not received in due time, the assigned stand space may be re-assigned and the deposit forfeited. Cancellation
